# **ECJ 28 September 2023, case C-320/21 P and C-321/21 P (Ryanair v. Commission), Miscellaneous**

## ***Ryanair DAC – v – European Commission, EU case***

### **Summary**

It was not necessary for the aid measure of Denmark and Sweden in favour of the airline SAS to benefit all undertakings that suffered damages caused by the COVID-19 pandemic. The ECJ's summary of the case is available [here](#).

### **Order**

The Court:

In case C-320/21 P

Dismisses the appeal;  
Orders Ryanair DAC to bear its own costs and to pay those incurred by the European Commission and SAS AB;  
Orders the French Republic and the Kingdom of Sweden to bear their own costs.

In case C-321/21 P:

Dismisses the appeal;  
Orders Ryanair DAC to bear its own costs and to pay those incurred by the European Commission and SAS AB;  
Orders the French Republic and the Kingdom of Denmark to bear their own costs.
