## ECJ 21 November 2024, case C-546/23 P (UG v Commission), Maternity and parental leave

## UG – v – European Commission, European case

## Summary

Clause 2(4) of the Framework Agreement on Parental Leave (96/34/EC) does not prohibit an employer from dismissing a worker who had taken parental leave where the dismissal was not due to the application for, or taking of, parental leave.

## Ruling

The Court (seventh Chamber):

Dismisses the appeal; Orders UG to bear her own costs and to pay those incurred by the European Commission.
